Tasks and assignments:

- 1. Try to identify (without the need for quantification) what are necessary raw materials for this product's production! Try to divide these raw materials according to their nature into renewable and non-renewable, affordable, and rare!

- 5. Choose the influences that are most important from the company's point of view!
- 6. Select those influences where, in your perception, the most significant difference in environmental impact among environmental and traditional products occurs!
- 7. Summarize conclusions and process them in the form of a PowerPoint presentation!
